



**Christian scholarship is a particular calling to Kingdom Service shared by everyone with a college education. The Kuyper Honors Program takes students exhibiting exceptional gifts in this area and helps them to cultivate this calling and explore what it means in their lives. Since**

- At least one semester of full-time university credit. Ordinarily, only students with no more than four semesters of university work completed will be considered for admission.
- Demonstrated academic ability at the university level with a minimum GPA of 3.25. Students with less than two semesters of university credit may be admitted conditionally pending the completion of a second semester of credit. Students with a GPA between 3.25 and 3.50 may be admitted conditionally pending their maintaining a 3.25 GPA.

... Your completed KHP application form.

... Your completed and signed application essay.

... Your two letters of recommendation from university faculty, using the attached form.

... Copies of your university level transcripts.

... If a transfer student, a completed Dordt University application, including transcripts.

For priority consideration, completed applications must be postmarked on or before February 1. Late applications will be considered as space allows.

Write a 1000-word, double-spaced essay that develops a thesis, uses the categories listed, and includes examples, to address the following question:

*What does it mean to be called to Christian Scholarship? What experiences (referencing particular books, courses, or projects) lead you to believe that this might be a calling in your life?*

Use a standard essay format (such as MLA, including citations), including a heading on the first page with your name, essay title, and mention of the Kuyper Honors Program. The essay must be entirely your own work, without any help in writing or editing. At the end of the essay, include the following statement and sign the essay: "This essay is entirely my own work and I received no assistance in writing or editing."
